Detailed description of the training Program (content) /Descripción detallada del programa de practicas:

Purpose of the Role:

The trainee will be providing support in all the activities developed by the Transitions Hub, a European Lab of new tools and methods for accelerating transitions from a high carbon to a low carbon society. The essential value provided as the Transition Hub as a Laboratory is the combination and adaptation of existing knowledge into tailored and

contextualized formats for practitioners. Most of the activities developed by the Hub take the form of international collaboration with other organizations.

General responsibilities:

The trainee's will take the role of research assistant. The responsibilities will include, but are not limited to the Transitions hub day-to-day operations in the core activities: applied research, co-creation of tools and methods for capacity building as well as running pilots on participatory process and technical assistance. It can also include the development of communication and other materials as well as the organization of profile-raising and other events in academic and policy forums.

Specific responsibilities:

The trainee will be involved in supporting the working plan under the Climate-KIC - Joint research Centre collaboration which include two main activities: 1) co-creation of content in the areas of regional policy and innovation and 2) organization of participatory process/technical assistance among Climate-KIC geographies in several topics such as energy transition, circular economy and climate adaptation.
